Major Pathways

This view illustrates the many interconnections of the cerebral cortex with other brain centers. Prominent among these tracts are the Thalamic Peduncles, that connect the Thalamus with the cortex, the tracts arising from the brainstem, and the radiations of the corpus callosum. Here the corpus callosum is only represented by a section, called the Splenium. This section contains pathways that interconnect the left and right occipital lobes.
